Mr. Leander Rabe, Organizational Developer with Hulings & Associates, LLC, welcomed committee members, called the meeting to order 4:34 p.m., and reviewed the Dynamic Planning Timeline. Superintendent Merritt and Ms. Bethany Rayl provided a recap of the work completed by the committee in previous meetings in order to bring all committee members up to date.

The committee discussed the importance of spending adequate time reviewing the specific language of each of the strategic goals to assure all high-level concepts are captured. Being certain language in the goals includes student voice, choice, engagement, equity, inclusion, and innovation was noted as essential.

The committee broke into subgroups, further analyzed and refined the language of the final goals, and shared their perspectives and revisions with the whole committee. The full committee spent a considerable amount of time discussing, voting on revisions, and reaching a consensus on three of the strategic goals.

After an exchange of ideas and further discussion, the committee decided to add a fifth strategic goal to provided clarity, include all essential concepts, and incorporate language in the goals that address community partnerships.

Due to time restraints, the committee was unable to complete its reiteration of two of the strategic goals. An additional steering committee meeting was scheduled for August 23, 2021, to allow committee members more time for discussion and finalization of the two remaining goals.

Committee members were asked to spend time this week fine-tuning their perspectives and come to the next meeting prepared to share their views.
