Superintendent's Report

Superintendent Merritt spoke about the severe weather that impacted our community and some of our district school buildings and facilities last week. She expressed appreciation to the P-CCS maintenance, construction, and bond teams that addressed flooding and restoration efforts to ensure school buildings are safe and ready for students to return. She also thanked our neighboring communities for sharing their facilities, allowing some P-CEP athletic teams to relocate while the flooded turf fields were assessed and restored.

Due to last week's storms, the Back to School Bash was rescheduled until the first day of school, September 5, 2023, from 1-4 p.m. in the Salem bus loop. Superintendent Merritt encouraged district families to stop by to take advantage of this opportunity to meet district leaders, tour the P-CEP campus, enjoy food, fun, and games, and learn about P-CCS programs.

She also spoke about the Teacher Welcome Back Event held this morning in the Gloria Logan Auditorium, where educators from across the district engaged in professional learning and participated in activities centered around the district's 2023-2024 theme, "Reach Higher." She gave a shout-out to the P-CEP Unifed Dance Team and the P-CEP Park Players for their outstanding performances, which were enjoyed by all.

She also acknowledged the significant donation of a 2022 Ford Bronco Raptor received by the Canton High School CTE Department. She expressed appreciation to Ford Motor Company for this generous donation to be used for training and instruction purposes for students at P-CEP.
