We want students to participate in a way that they feel comfortable. Students have the choice to not run, to run on a path that has no color being sprayed on students, or to run on a path that has color being sprayed on students.

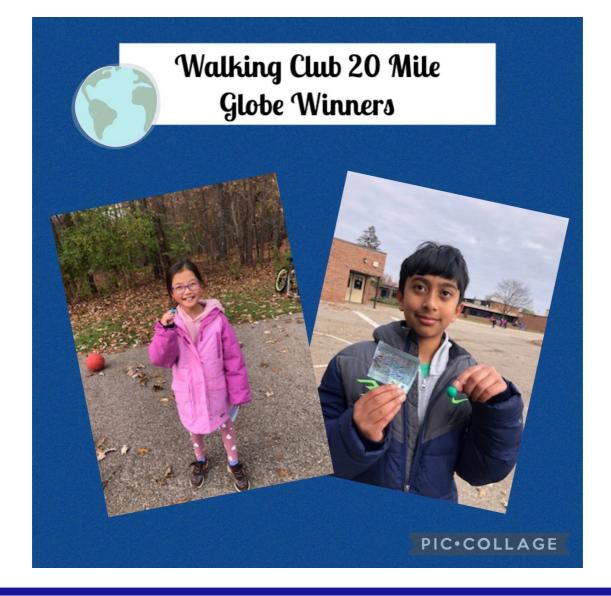
