Think. Pair. Share. Activity (Dr. Liz Vartanian-Gibbs)

Students worked together on the Think. Pair. Share. Activity. Students shared the following information:

- We should discuss more from the SVA meetings with the middle school student councils.
- We should also think about fundraisers for SVA.
- We need to discuss the norms we set from last year.
- We established leadership for this year.
- This year we can create ideas and do things we are passionate about.
- We like that we had forms posted in our schools to seek suggestions.
- We want to solve some problems. Solve problems involving our community.
- I have heard of other districts having monthly mental health days. It would be great if we could do the same even once every quarter.
- We need better advertising for anything we do.
- We need a better grading system in our school district.
- We would like more middle school activities after school.
- We like that everyone who applied was accepted.
- All students were given opportunities to speak out during the meeting

JamBoard Activity (Saee Pawar)

What should we do as a group? What action can we take?

Saee shared that at a prior meeting, we completed a Jamboard activity. Below are the ideas from the activity:

- How can we include all students in SVA?

- Try to see if homeroom at P-CEP can occur more than once a week.
- How is the student voice going to be shown in Virtual Academy?

- Can we get more communication from teachers regarding the mental health of students?
- Can we work to help students with their workload?
- Can non-members improve SVA? If not, could we also encourage non-members to come to the meetings?
- More Action! We want more action and more change!
- Why can't the students pick their high school?
- Can we do college visits in high school?

Students at the meeting had an opportunity to share additional ideas they would like to address. Below is the list:

- How can we include all students in SVA and include all voices?
- Many people don't know about the Google Form created to get recommendations for change. How can we market the survey and get more responses?
- How can we get the voice of elementary students in SVA and act on it?
- How can non-members improve SVA?
- Can we help limit the workloads of students?
- I would like more rules for walking between classes.
- Can we get more communication with teachers about the mental health of students?
- Can we reach out to clubs and partner with them?
- Can we ask 5th-grade students their opinions?
- Can we provide more resources to support queer youth?
- Some of the school lunches available don't support dietary restrictions.
- Can the Media Centers @ P-CEP stay open until 6pm?
- Can more support be provided for students who have some challenges?
- A separate area should be provided in all schools for students who celebrate Ramadan. Separate area. Fair and equal space for students
- Can all teachers at P-CEP play the announcements?
- Social/emotional learning at the middle schools

- Eliminate some questions
- Please allocate 10-15 minutes to complete the Google Form.M

- Email address. Just put a short answer
- Fewer questions.
