Board Workshop

The Board of Education held a workshop with Superintendent Merritt and Mr. Gary Collins, legal counsel with Collins and Blaha, to discuss updates to the superintendent evaluation tool.

Mr. Collins provided Rater Reliability Training, outlining the new evaluation procedures established by Michigan legislation. The training covered the statutory framework, the development of local evaluation tools, and recent changes to the evaluation process. Key updates include introducing a mid-year review, a 20% weight on student growth in the evaluation rating, and integrating goals into each evaluation domain.

During the meeting, the team also developed and set goals for the Superintendent and Board for the 2024-2025 school year. A copy of the final goals will be shared with the Board at the next meeting for review and approval.
